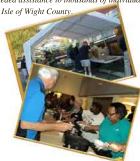


Isle of Wight Christian Outreach Program (COP)

COP was formed in 1991, when 13 Isle of Wight churches hosted a community fundraiser to assist some neighbors with the cost of winter fuel. That event, known as "Soup Saturday," was the beginning of a wonderful collection of benefactors and community events that have provided much needed assistance to thousands of individuals in Isle of Wight County.



The community spirit that brought us together in 1991 has evolved into an all volunteer organization with 10 programs that assist the elderly, the poor, the uninsured and the disenfranchised in Isle of Wight County.
